

Service Hour Opportunities

Per the Parent Agreement, "To devote a minimum of twenty-four (24) hours of volunteer service *per family* to the school by June 1st of this school year or pay a fee of \$360.00 (\$15.00/hour). If half of the service hours have not been completed by January 31, 2019, \$180.00 will be due by February 15, 2019. Also, each family must devote a minimum of six (6) hours of volunteer service at the annual Harvest Festival in November, or pay \$25.00 per hour for each hour not completed. If more than six hours are worked, that amount will be applied to your annual required service hours of 30. Additionally, Yard Duty is sometimes a mandatory part of your required 30 hours. A separate yard duty flyer is enclosed.

Listed below are numerous possibilities to obtain your service hours. Please check off which areas are of interest to you and return this form to the Attendance Office. **(Checking an area does not constitute commitment to the task - you will be contacted by the person in charge and can get details and schedules at that time).**

NOTE: Service hours **WILL NOT** be given for Scouting activities, RCIA participation, or Religious Education instruction, as these activities are not **SERVICE** to the **SCHOOL**. The school is required, as one of the ministries in the parish, to serve coffee and donuts. Service hours will be given for that Sunday Hospitality activity.
